From 5th -6th December 2018, the 3rd partner meeting of the project Improving the professional skills in green constructions through online training with Project number Nr. 2017-1- LV01-KA202-035483 took place in Frankfurt am Main, Germany, hosted by Project Partner Schnellkraft Personalmanagement Ltd.

During the meeting project partners discussed the following key points:

3. The participants in the meeting decided that each partner should come up with an assessment of modules - content, innovation by 15.12.2018

4. The dissemination activities in the partner countries are presented.

ABOUT THE FORTHCOMING PROJECT ACTIVITIES:

1. The modules will be translated in the languages of the 4 partner countries (DE, LV, BG, HU).

2. The event Train of the trainers will take place in Rezekne from 21 to 26.01.2019. 12 tutors (3 LV, 3 BG, 3 DE, 3 HU) will be trained to work with the trainees during the pilot trainings. The tutors will be trained in the methodology and an instrument for a work with the platform. They will be trained in the content of each module – Program, Case studies, Exercises, Test and training materials
