OBJECTIVES AND TASKS OF THE SURVEY



- The dissemination activities in the partner's countries were presented.





FORTHCOMING PROJECT ACTIVITIES

- 1. The modules will be translated in each partner's language (DE, LV, BG, HU).
- 2. The event "Train of the trainers" will be organised in Rezekne from 21. to 26.01.2019.
- 12 tutors (3 LV, 3 BG, 3 DE, 3 HU) will be trained to work with the trainees during the pilot tests. The tutors will be trained in the methodology and how to work with the platform.
